



BC Hockey Player Development Coordinator

Request for Interested Candidates

BC Hockey is currently seeking a Player Development Coordinator to provide technical information, oversight and monitor the delivery of the Long-Term Player Development program as developed by Hockey Canada. In addition, the Player Development Coordinator will lead a committee on new hockey technical components as well as administrative and operational standards for player development.

In carrying out the duties above, the Player Development Coordinator will exercise its authority in accordance with BC Hockey Bylaws, Regulations and Policies and such additional provisions as set out below.

Key Duties

The Player Development Coordinator shall perform the following key duties:

- Work with Player Development Committee to continually develop, implement and revise Development plans at all divisions within Minor Hockey.
- Consult Hockey Canada Long Term Player Development Model (LTPD) and create programming based on the development principles within.
- Liaises with provincial and national LTPD organizations.
- Create best practise plans for all divisions of minor hockey, both high performance and recreational.
- Create seasonal plan best practices.
- Create monthly learning outcomes/skill development competencies for all divisions of minor hockey.
- Develop player/parent feedback system to support, enhance and track player development.
- Liaise with Male and Female High Performance Coordinators to better understand player requirements for high performance and provincial teams.
- Liaise with BC Hockey Coach Coordinator to develop enhanced services clinics/presentations on hockey technical items.
- Identify strategies to ensure programming can be delivered throughout the province.
- Develop Minor Hockey Association Evaluation criteria and observation plan to review player development.
- Work with BC Hockey Strength and Conditioning Coach to develop off-ice nutrition, rest and exercise best practices.
- Participate in provincial and national seminars on player development.

Composition

The Player Development Coordinator shall work with a BC Hockey staff resource and the Player Development Committee members, which are composed of:

- Committee Chair – Technical Director
- A Board Director assigned to act as a liaison between the Committee and the Board. (non-voting)
- Committee members - 4-8 Subject Matter Specialists
- BC Hockey staff member (non-voting)





Meetings

The Player Development Coordinator will actively participate in Player Development Committee meeting. As well as be part of the BC Hockey Coordinator meetings . Most meetings will be held via conference call, however the group will also meet in person at least once per year.
