Town History

David Thompson explored the section of the Columbia River that passes through the present town site of Golden in 1807.

However, significant interest in the area did not come about until the search for a pass through the Rocky Mountains to enable construction of the CP Rail line from coast to coast in the 1850s brought the Palliser expedition to the area. Sir James Hector, a geologist who was part of the expedition, was kicked by a horse on his travels and narrowly escaped death. He named the pass through the mountains and the river that flows through Golden Kicking Horse Pass and Kicking Horse River respectively.

In the 1880's a way through the Selkirk Mountains was discovered by Major A.B. Rogers. The pass that bears his name allowed construction of the final parts of the railway linking east to west to proceed.

The first settlement in Golden, associated with Major Roger's survey party, happened in 1882

Integral to the history of Golden was the role that the Swiss mountain guides played. Canadian Pacific Railway employed mountaineering guides from Switzerland, starting in 1899, to guide passengers on mountain climbing expeditions. Homes constructed in the early part of the 20th century for the guides remain a testament to this part of the area's heritage.



Information on Golden and Area

Golden is located between the Canadian Rocky Mountains and Columbia Mountain ranges and with close proximity to six of the most stunning national parks that Canada has to offer; Banff, Glacier, Jasper, Kootenay, Mount Revelstoke and Yoho, Golden BC

Golden also sits at the confluence of the Kicking Horse River, a Canadian heritage river famous for white water rafting, and the Columbia River, a BC heritage river which meanders through the longest protected wetlands in North America.

Golden is home to Kicking Horse Mountain Resort, where you can experience some of the best skiing in North America and during the summer months downhill biking and the grizzly bear refuge are both open.

We have an award-winning golf course, extensive downhill and cross country mountain biking terrain, some of the best white water rafting in the world, vast snowmobiling terrain for sledders of all abilities.

Driving Instructions:

Golden is located at the intersection of Hwy-1 (Trans Canada) and Rt-95 in southeast British Columbia, approx. 260 km west of Calgary and approx. 700 km northeast of Vancouver.

From the West: Hwy-1 (Trans Canada) east to Radium/Golden/Hwy-95 exit. Proceed southwest approx. 0.25 km to Golden/Hwy-95 (10 Avenue). Proceed south on 10 Ave. approx. 1 km to 9 St. (just across river). Turn left on 9 St. and proceed east approx. 0.5 km to 14 Avenue. Bear left onto 14 Ave. and proceed a short distance to arena on the right.

From the East: Hwy-1 (Trans Canada) West to Radium/Golden/Hwy-95 exit. Proceed southwest approx. 0.25 km to Golden/Hwy-95 (10 Avenue). Proceed south on 10 Ave. approx. 1 km to 9 St. (just across river). Turn left on 9 St. and proceed east approx. 0.5 km to 14 Avenue. Bear left onto 14 Ave. and proceed a short distance to arena on the right.

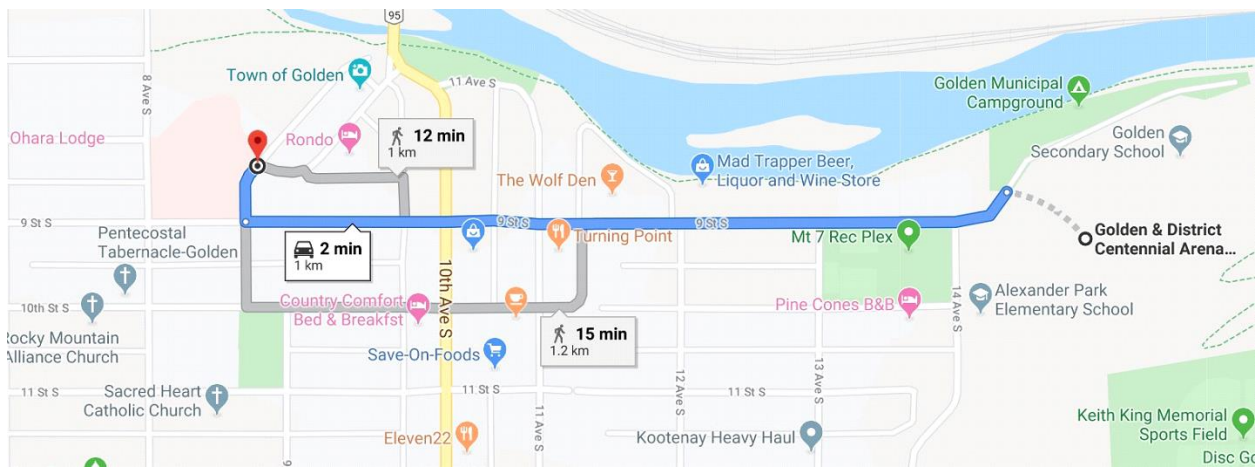

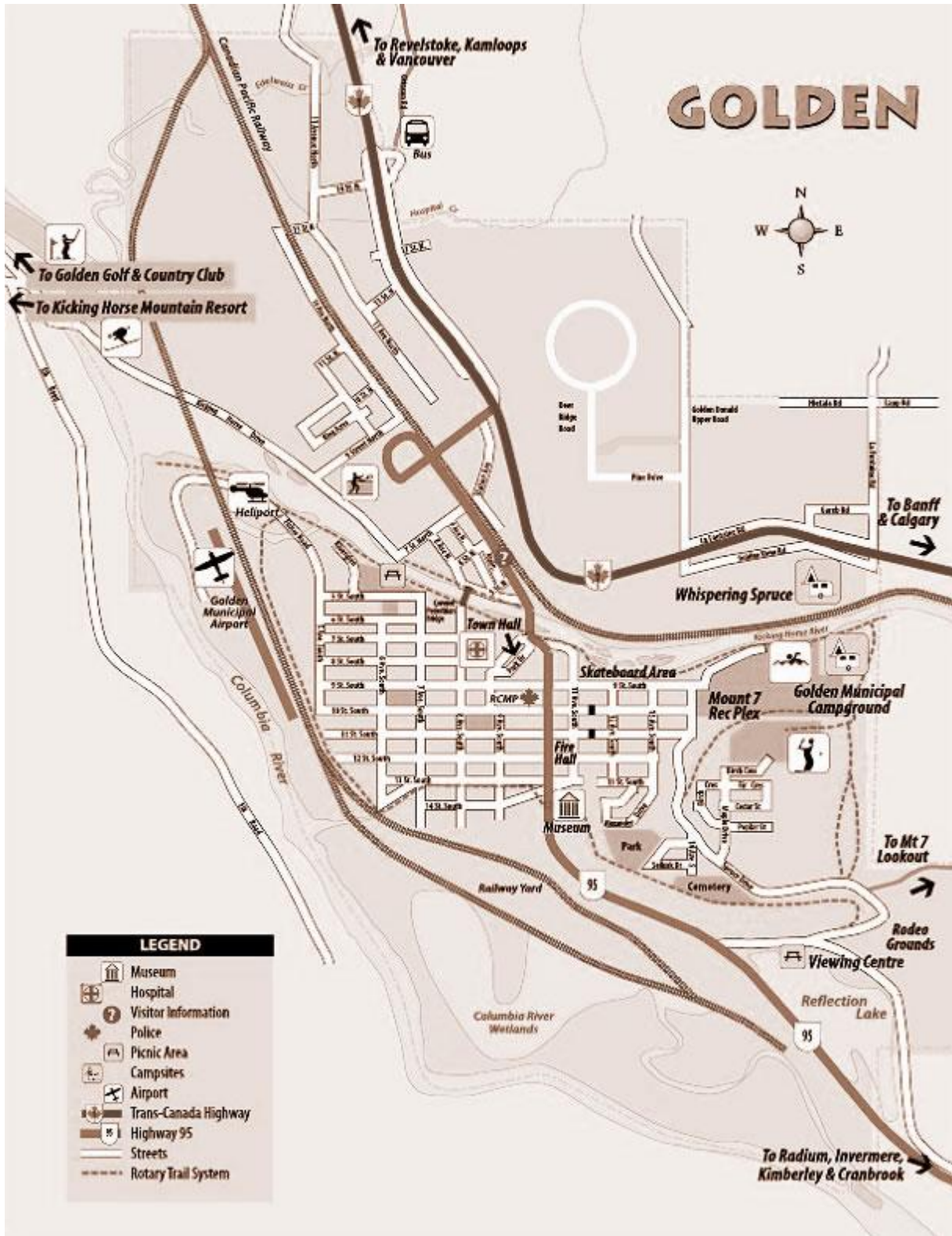
