

**Program Delivery Group – High Performance Officiating**

<p><b>Mandate</b></p>	<p>The High Performance (HP) Officiating Delivery Group is responsible for overseeing the delivery of the Hockey Canada Officiating Program (HCOP) components at the levels identified within the HP development stream. Continuity of supervision and evaluation of officials at this level are delivered in collaboration with the High Performance Officiating Facilitator.</p> <p>The HP Officiating program includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Midget AAA [Major Midget, Minor Midget &amp; Midget Prep (CSSHL)]</li> <li>• Junior B (PJHL, VIJHL &amp; KIJHL)</li> <li>• College (BCIHL)</li> <li>• Junior A (BCHL), coordination with the BCHL Director of Officiating</li> <li>• USport – HP Officiating Facilitator assigns Linesmen</li> </ul>
<p><b>Key Duties</b></p>	<p>The HP Officiating Delivery Group will perform the following key duties:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Organize and deliver pre-season certification and clinic delivery</li> <li>• Maintain program material inventory (as required)</li> <li>• Annually deliver HP fitness testing</li> <li>• Identify, schedule and monitor supervisory personnel</li> <li>• Provide recommendations for official advancement or upgrade</li> <li>• Attend District events to represent program (as required)</li> <li>• Relay operational issues to Program Advisory Group</li> <li>• Liaise with League President(s) or representatives</li> <li>• Identify prospect officials for the HP Officiating program</li> <li>• Recommend discipline of officials (as required)</li> </ul>
<p><b>Composition</b></p>	<p>The HP Officiating Delivery Group will be composed of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Co-Chairs – Officiating Coordinator and HP Officiating Facilitator</li> <li>• Deliver Group Members will be allocated at the District level:             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• HP Officiating Lead - Lower Mainland</li> <li>• HP Officiating Lead – Vancouver Island</li> <li>• HP Officiating Lead - Interior</li> <li>• HP Officiating Assigner(s)* (not an application)</li> </ul> </li> </ul> <p>* If required. The Deliver Group Member for each District will be responsible for overseeing game assignments. If deemed appropriate, they may appoint a designated assigner to assist with game scheduling logistics. An assigner is not an application-based position.</p> <p>It is the responsibility of the HP Officiating Deliver Group Chairs to recommend members of this group. Members are to be approved by the Chief Executive Officer (CEO).</p>
<p><b>Qualifications</b></p>	<p>The HP Officiating Delivery Group shall be qualified as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Maintain a minimum HCOP Level 3             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Including valid Criminal Record Check (CRC)</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Possess valid Respect in Sport (RIS) certification</li> <li>• Excellent knowledge of the HCOP Rules</li> <li>• Possess the respect of officials within the BC Hockey program.</li> </ul>

<b>Appointment</b>	<p>Upon application, the HP Officiating Deliver Group will be recommended to the BC Hockey Chief Executive Officer (CEO) by the Officiating Coordinator.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Appointed by the CEO</li><li>• The CEO shall determine the appointment process, job description and annual performance review of the appointee(s). Notification of the required positions will be circulated annually (incumbents are required to indicate a desire to continue in the position).</li></ul>
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
